Spring was slow to arrive in the Northern US and arrived with a vengeance in the south. With coming out of 2 years of navigating Covid 19 and now in a year of extreme uncertainty on so many levels, we find ourselves needing to make hard choices.

Between the pandemic, climate chaos, inflation and the ongoing war in Ukraine, we have plenty to occupy our thoughts. With each of these issues, Family Farm Defenders remains solid in trying to disseminate the issues and providing quality information that all of us can use in our daily lives and activities. In the early beginnings of Family Farm Defenders, through the "Dump the Dairy Board" campaign, it was recognized that - Like a Giant Spider Web - all things are interconnected. Knowing that the ultimate goal is establishing Food Sovereignty, our mission is to navigate through the many issues towards building that path. Recent numbers also show that we are down to barely 30,000 dairy farms across the entire US. Another area of concern, as mega dairies expand and the opportunity for disaster also grows.

Our climate is posing another area of concern. When can we plant? If we plant, will it even grow? How are food supplies going to be affected? With inflation also surging, how will all of us be affected?

Part of a plan may be to plant a garden. Stock up on some staple items. Is it time to go out and meet your farmer? Personally knowing someone who is growing your food could be a good strategy!
